

This activity is a 'UMA' from the Express Myself (dark pink) theme. It counts for 15 minutes - remember you eventually need to have 300 minutes of UMA's for each theme.

Aim of activity: Try your hand at upcycling an old t-shirt to create a brand-new reusable bag.

What you'll need:

- An old t-shirt
- Scissors
- Safety pin

What to do:

You don't have to follow these exact instructions, there are lots of different ideas on the internet and you might find it easier to follow a video of someone else making the bag – have a look on YouTube.

- 1. Take your t-shirt and cut off the sleeves inside the seam, as in picture A.
- 2. Cut the sleeves into strips about 3cm wide. Cut them so they are no longer a circle and stretch them out.
- 3. To make the handles of the bag, cut out the t-shirt neck as shown in picture A. You can choose the shape you cut v-shaped, round or square.
- 4. Go to the bottom of the t-shirt. Turn it inside out and cut three slits into the hem, as shown in picture B.
- 5. Take a sleeve strip and attach a safety pin to one end. Thread it through one of the slits and pull it round the hem to the next one, as in picture C.
- 6. Pull the strip tight, then tie it in a knot as tight as you can, like in picture D. Repeat this with the other slits so that you have three holes tied.
- 7. Finally, tie the stings from each knot to each other, then cut off the excess material or make a bow. Turn your bag so it's no longer inside out.
- 8. Feel free to decorate your bag if you want to.
- 9. Send us a picture so that we can sign the activity off and add the time to your record.
